Eligibility Criteria:

Student must:

Application Period

Students are expected to submit their application at least 1 month before the start date of the internship programme.

Applications will be processed on a rolling basis. Applicants will be notified of their NUS Global Internship Award results via their NUS email addresses.

Terms and Conditions

Students must submit a report (with photos) of their experiential learning in the country, within 2 weeks after the end of the programme, using this prescribed [template](#).

Students must upload a resume (including details of their participation in the overseas programme) at [NUS TalentConnect](#), within 2 weeks after the end of the programme. The resume uploaded will be made accessible to IE Singapore and the Singapore companies working with IE Singapore, for their talent recruitment purposes. Disbursement

The NUS Global Internship Award will be disbursed on a reimbursement basis i.e. after the internship. Funding by IE Singapore Young Talent Programme – Market Immersion will be disbursed after the internship, following the completion of deliverables.
