Before You Start

Please ensure that the applicant has submitted a scholarship application before you are able to submit a report. You will also need to obtain the information below from the applicant.

1. NUS Application Number of Scholarship Applicant (an 8-digit number given to the applicant after he/she has applied for undergraduate admissions to NUS)
2. Full Name of Scholarship Applicant (as per their NUS admission application form)
3. Date of Birth of Scholarship Applicant

Submission

When providing the applicant particulars, kindly remove any additional spaces, if any (e.g. 30123456<space>). You will not be able to submit the referee report, if any of the applicant particulars is incorrect and do not match our records.

Please also note that you have to complete and submit the report in one sitting, as the report cannot be saved before submission. Please ensure that all information is correct before submitting, as you will not be able to edit the report after submission. In the event of multiple entries, only the latest submission by the stipulated deadline will be accepted.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

1. How will the applicant know that NUS has received my submission of the referee report?
Applicant may log in to the [Online Application Status Facility](#) to check the status of the report submission.
2. I am nominated as a referee by a few applicants, will this be a problem?
No. You may submit referee reports for multiple applicants.
3. Is there a word limit for open-ended questions?
No. However, you should keep to the space provided in the online form.
4. Why does NUS need my official work email address?
It is important that we ensure data authenticity and integrity. As such, we will appreciate if you could provide us with your official work email address.
5. How do I edit my report for an applicant after I have already submitted it? I have missed out something really important.
No amendments can be made after submission.
