A BRIEF HISTORY

Previously PGP Residence 5 (R5), the residence first introduced its flagship Peer Mentorship Programme (PMP) in 2016. The suite of programmes at R5 were then expanded in 2017 to include academic modules and Interest Groups. In doing so, R5 made way for the first of its kind in NUS – PGP House.



OUR PROGRAMME

PGP House provides a balanced one-year living and learning programme for freshmen, and aims to help freshmen settle into university life by providing a familial and well-supported residential environment.



The signature Peer Mentorship Programme offers freshmen an opportunity to receive course-specific academic guidance and student life-related care from a selected group of dedicated seniors (i.e. "Peer Mentors"). In addition, Resident Fellows (RFs) and Resident Assistants (RAs) are readily available to provide pastoral care and support.



Freshmen are also encouraged to participate and even lead <u>Interest Groups</u> (IGs), pursuing a wide array of interests such as sports, arts, and enrichment activities.

INTEREST GROUPS GROUND-UP INITIATIVES

Interest Groups are ground-up initiatives led by passionate residents that allow first-timers to try something new, and at the same time also give seasoned individuals opportunities to hone their skills.

Residents are also welcomed to initiate their own Interest Groups to pursue and share their interests with others.

PGP HOUSE

MANAGEMENT TEAM & STUDENT LEADERS

House Master

Provides overall leadership and direction to PGP House, and is responsible for the residents' welfare, discipline and quality of residential life.

Manager

Oversees the administration, management, operation and financial processes of PGP House.

Resident Fellow (RF)

RFs are Academic or Executive & Professional staff appointed to live in a Hall of Residence. They enhance the residential life experience of students living in the Halls and serve as advisors and mentors. They also serve as community builders and provide pastoral care to residents.

Resident Assistant (RA)

RAs are appointed student leaders who provide pastoral care, provide guidance and help to residents, and enforce housing guidelines. There are 3 RAs per 2 blocks in PGP House.

Student Council (SC)

The SC is a body of elected student leaders who oversees the welfare, planning of events and ensures that residents' voices are heard and attended to. The SC comprises 9 to 11 positions with different roles and responsibilities.

Peer Mentor (PM) / Cluster Leader (CL)

PMs are Year 2 to 4 senior undergraduates who excel academically and who are able to provide student life-related guidance to freshmen through the Peer Mentorship Program. As cluster leaders, they also organize activities for their clusters.

Graduate Fellow (GF)

Leads the Peer Mentorship Programme and provides guidance to the Peer Mentors.

Interest Group Leader (IGL)

IGLs are appointed student leaders who lead the respective interest groups, with activities ranging from sports, arts to baking and music.

FACILITIES

Lounges: Common areas for students to mingle, chill and relax.

Location: two in B1 (24hr), one in every two block (open from 7am-11pm;

block 20/21 & 22/23 on 2nd floor and 24/25 on 1st floor)

Study rooms: Common areas for students to study and work. All open 24 hours. Need

card key to access and automatically locks once the door is closed.
"Choping (saving)" the seat for longer than 2 hours is prohibited; PGP

House can remove the belongings if spotted.

Location: some on 1st floor, some at B1 (reading room, seminar room)

Water cooler: There are water coolers throughout the entire PGPR. Most commonly used

except the one in PGP House: one beside the gym and one on the way to

the bus stop (R3).

Location: 1st floor near entrance, beside the bending machine

Printing room: Open 24 hours. Black & white only, S\$ 0.03 per page. Need to get the

cardiflex card (can buy from the spot) in order to use the printer.

Location: Beside the water cooler, in the seminar room in front of the common washroom of block 22/23. There are two other printing room across PGPR; one in level 2 lounge located above Super Snacks (R3) and

another at level 1 lounge of R2 (near e-canteen)

Laundry rooms: Note: Open 24 hours. Have washing machine and dryers. Operated by \$1

coins and EZlink card (There is coin exchanger beside the main office).

Bring your own detergent and softener (if needed).

Location: below block 20 (B1) and block 24 (B1)

Auditorium: Location: B1 under the main office (foyer)

Note: No fixed opening hours; major events and PGP House movie nights

held here

BBQ pit: Location: near the back entrance, outside of block 24/25

Operating hours: need to be booked before usage

FACILITIES

MPH: Location: B1 under the Nanyang Mart

Operating hours: 7am to 10am, 3pm to 11pm from Monday to Friday; 8am to

11am, 3pm to 11pm from Saturday to Sunday

Note: No fixed opening hours; some IG (interest group) and major events

happen here. Can book from main office to play badminton.

Function room: Location: B1 under the main office (foyer)

Note: There are 5 function rooms. Some IG (interest group) and

GER/GEQ modules take place in these function rooms. Have table tennis

table beside them.

Gym: Location: B1 under the main office (foyer)

Operating hours: 7am to 10am, 3pm to 11pm from Monday to Friday; 8am

to 11am, 3pm to 11pm from Saturday to Sunday

Basketball court: Location: Outdoor, outside block 24/25

Operating hours: lights turned off at 11pm

Note: some IGs take place here. Official gathering location for fire drill and disasters. Have caged court as well, which is usually used for soccer

and other sports.

Tennis court: Location: Outdoor, beside the caged court

Operating hours: lights off at 11pm
