Download the NUS career+ app from Google Playstore (android phones) or Apple store (iOS).






Launch the app once downloaded and login using NUS email address
















### Onboarding.

NUS career+ will be able to track the courses users have taken and extract the skills users have gained from them.










## Onboarding.

Users may also upload a CV to extract the skills that go beyond what users have learned in class.










### Onboarding.

Roles will be populated for users to choose from depending on your skills, but users are free to search for others that you are more interested in.












#### Home.


- Users can view their Career Readiness Index based on the selections they have made for their aspired roles

#### Jobs.







#### Learn.

Users will be able to view full list of recommended courses and full list of courses under "Recommended Courses", "Discover All" respectively together with their specific course details.










#### **Events. - For current students**

Students will have full access to latest career workshops, career fairs and career briefings.






#### **Profile.**

The upward trend line signifies an increasing need for this skill, while a straight line shows a constant demand, and a downward line suggests a falling demand.
