

1. Login (https://nus-csm.symplicity.com) as a Student using either UserID@u.nus.edu or UserID




2. Click on your Profile > My Documents to upload your latest resume




Applying to Internships


- 1. You can now apply for internships!

b. You can use the "Position Type" filter to view all available NUS IAAS internships and find your ideal opportunity.




c. Select the "Internship-As-A-Service (IAAS)" checkbox.




3. Check the status of your applications and accept any offers under the 'Applications' tab.

Student Declaration

Declaration 1 *

I declare that I do not have a relationship with any member of the management of the company or any other relationship which could give rise to a conflict-of-interest situation.

Declaration 2 *

I declare that my application under the NUS IAAS scheme complies with the programme requirements (e.g. IA, VIA, etc) specified by my faculty/school. Non-compliance will result in withdrawal of my NUS IAAS project.

Declaration 3 *

- I understand that NUS IAAS project and reports are to be completed and acknowledged by the business no later than Week 12 of the academic calendar (Semester 1 & 2).
- For graduating cohort, NUS IAAS project and reports are to be completed before Week 12 of the final semester. For Special Terms, please check with CFG.

Declaration 4 *

I understand that only a maximum of 8 units, made up of DYOC and NUS IAAS courses, will be counted towards graduation requirements. Any excess units accumulated from NUS IAAS projects will not be considered for graduation.
