You can apply for all the listed awards and scholarships, but you are eligible to receive only one award. Countries/regions for which the <u>Singapore Ministry of Foreign Affairs</u> has issued an ongoing travel advisory on, will not be eligible for funding.

Category of Funding	Awards
Description	To ease students' financial concerns on embarking on overseas internships, NUS offers financial support through the NUS Global Internship Award (NGIA) for all NUS undergraduate students embarking on an overseas internship. Through an overseas internship experience that is supported by NGIA, we aim to enhance students' global exposure by gaining wider business and cultural perspectives. This overseas experience will also build the students' adaptability, independence and resilience to be future-ready for the workforce.

Category of Funding	Loans
Description	Overseas Student Programme (OSP) loan is offered to all NUS undergraduates who are embarking on NUS approved overseas programmes. This loan is to help students cover their expenses during the course of the overseas stint.
Quantum	Loan amount is between S\$2,000 and S\$5,000
Eligibility Criteria	 Applicant details: Be Singapore Citizens Be an NUS full-time undergraduate, participating in a university-approved overseas programme.
