Students - Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Suspension of NUS Internships-As-A-Service (IAAS) for New Postings

1. What are the changes?

- NUS CFG is suspending IAAS for new postings while conducting a review to improve part-time internship and work-while-studying schemes.
- Existing and approved IAAS postings will proceed as planned.

2. Why is IAAS being suspended for new postings?

- Feedback from employers, faculties, and students highlighted concerns about the number and timing of internships during the academic term.
- The review aims to provide a more balanced approach that ensures meaningful learning while safeguarding students' academic progress and well-being.

3. How long will the suspension last?

• The review is in progress. Updates and an indicative re-launch timeline will be shared in the coming months.

4. Will ongoing IAAS internships proceed as planned?

• Yes. All ongoing and approved IAAS internships will continue under the current terms agreed with employers. Students who complete their internships and submit the required reports (with employer acknowledgement) will still be able to enrol under the IAAS programme.

5. What happens if I have applied for an IAAS role?

• If the posting has already been approved and published, your application will remain valid, and the employer may proceed to hire you as planned.

6. If I have received a verbal or written offer from an employer, but the IAAS posting is pending approval, what steps should I take?

 Please inform us, and we will connect the employer with their assigned Industry Relations Manager to assist with any queries.

7. I applied for an IAAS role before the suspension. Will I still be considered?

• If the posting has already been approved and published, your application will continue to be processed, and the employer may proceed to hire you. Please confirm your acceptance with the employer in TalentConnect by the end of this week (19 September).
