Janet Ang is a visionary leader, a pioneer who has led a trail-blazing path in Information and Communications Technology, or ICT, for others to emulate. Today, the University is honoured to pay tribute to Janet for her many accomplishments, which have impacted the ICT industry in Singapore, in a stellar career spanning more than three decades.

Janet had an illustrious 37-year career in the ICT industry, notably with IBM in Singapore, China and Japan. During her years at IBM as Managing Director and IBM Vice President, Industry Solutions, IBM Asia Pacific, she had orchestrated much collaboration in education and research between IBM and NUS.

Appointed Chairman of the Institute of Systems Science (ISS) at NUS, in 2016, Janet wasted no time in steering NUS-ISS to be the foremost industry leader for developing digital talent. Under her watch, NUS-ISS doubled its size of business operations and established numerous industry partnerships including its appointment as the operations partner of The Digital Academy for the Singapore government. She is also instrumental in bringing together a collaborative ecosystem amongst NUS-ISS and other institutions of higher learning.

As many can attest to, Janet has been and still is, a foremost beacon in the ICT industry. Her drive to introduce, implement and integrate digitalisation to transform businesses stems from her strong belief in creating value to those she serves. She is a firm advocate for skills development – a necessity in today's complex world where

we have to constantly learn and reinvent ourselves to be adaptable for resilient careers and industry business transformation. Janet's commitment to purposeful stewardship missions in the community is well known to many. She serves as Chairman of SISTIC.com Pte Ltd, Singapore Polytechnic and the Caritas Singapore Agape Fund Board of Trustees. She is an independent Director on the Boards of Singapore Press Holdings Ltd, the Bank of the Philippine Islands, The Esplanade Company Ltd and Home Team Science & Technology Agency. She is also Singapore's Non-Resident Ambassador to the Holy See and currently serves as a Nominated Member of Parliament.
