MBZUAI's Internship Application requirements:

- Undergraduate students in the third/fourth year of STEM-related majors with a CGPA of 3.75 (on a 5.0 scale) or equivalent who will commence the final semester of their studies in FALL (or in a later semester) after the UGRIP
- Official enrolment letter from the University Registrar that includes registration status, admission date, program duration/expected graduation date
- Official academic transcript that includes all registered courses from the first until the current semester with course names, grades and credit hours
- Statement of Purpose. In an essay, explain why you would like to participate in the UGRIP at MBZUAI and include the following information:
 - Motivation for applying
 - Personal and academic background and how it makes you suitable for the UGRIP
 - Stand-out achievements (e.g., awards, distinction, etc.)
 - Goals as a prospective UGRIP participant
 - Preferred career path and plans
 - Any other details that will support the application
- Official evidence of English language proficiency, such as an official letter from the University Registrar confirming that English is the medium of instruction at the applicant's university or a valid certificate of any of the following:
 - TOEFL iBT with a minimum total score of 90
 - IELTS Academic with a minimum overall score of 6.5
- Colored copy of passport (valid for at least one year)
- All submitted documents must either be in English, originally, or
 include legal English translations. Additionally, official academic
 documents should be stamped and signed by the university
 authorities.

The application deadline is <u>28 February 2025 (5:00 PM UAE time / 9:00 PM SG time)</u>.



9	Confirmation of participation	Applicants will be notified by 1 April 2025 (11:00 PM UAE time) if their application is successful.

10	Course Mapping	All course mapping requests are subject to approval by the faculties/departments.
		If you are interested in obtaining credits for your course, you can start the course mapping process via EduRec-GE after you have accepted the programme offer.
		Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme. Over the course of study in NUS, students may map up to a total of 12 units for involvement in the summer programme. Beyond 12 units, NUS Special Term tuition fees will apply, in addition to Summer/Winter Programme fees paid to the host university.
