8	Module Mapping	<p>If you are interested in obtaining credit, please check with your Faculty on the module mapping process. Note that all mapping requests are subjected to approval by the Faculties.</p> <p>Total of 12 MCs from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional MCs mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees. For details, visit the Registrar's Office website.</p>
