4	Academic Content	The Ashoka Summer Research Programme offers undergraduate and master's students from both international partner and non-partner universities an opportunity to engage in cutting-edge, interdisciplinary research at Ashoka University. Participants will work closely with faculty mentors and their research groups, which include graduate and PhD students. Students will apply to the available research projects put out by Ashoka faculty/lab of their interest and technical skills.	

		The program aims to expose students to a wide range of new concepts and research techniques, enhancing their critical thinking and scientific curiosity. Upon completion of the summer research, students will have the opportunity to present their work to their peers, mentors, and the larger research community, and will receive a certificate of completion. Proceed to apply in <u>NUS Education Records System (EduRec)</u> once the programme has been set up and proceed with course mapping application (if you would like to map it back).

		Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme and up to a maximum of 5 units for each Winter Programme. Course mapping will be subject to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools.
		A total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional units mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees. For details, visit the <u>Office of the University Registrar's website</u> .
