Through a series of English-based lectures, cultural tours, and activities, students are expected to gain knowledge about different environmental, historical, and sociocultural facets of Taiwan. Exploring Taiwan classes allow students to understand how Taiwan's past has shaped its modern state, and the subtle ways Taiwan embraces foreign culture with its local culture.
