4	Academic Content	The 2025 +R1 Research and Culture Program provides international students the opportunity and the resources to engage in NTU professors’ research or state-of-the-art laboratories. Students will improve research skills and knowledge in a specific area of interest under the supervision of NTU faculty members during this intensive 6-week program.

The lectures provide in-depth studies on specific social-cultural aspects of Taiwan. The cultural tours and activities supplement students' learning from class lectures. Through a series of English-based lectures, cultural tours, and activities, students are expected to gain knowledge about different environmental, historical, and sociocultural facets of Taiwan. Exploring Taiwan classes allow students to understand how Taiwan's past has shaped its modern state, and the subtle ways Taiwan embraces foreign culture with its local culture.</p>

The final selection is by NTU. The GPA requirement is a minimum of 2.7 (upon 4.3), which is approximately 3.14 (upon 5) in NUS' context.</p> <p>Note: Freshmen and sophomores must obtain approval from their selected NTU faculty professor BEFORE applying. Admission is subject to evaluation.</p>

You must accept both <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The EduRec offer and • host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme. <p>✓ Only upon acceptance of the EduRec offer can you proceed with course mapping and application for financial aids.</p> <p>✓ Applying on EduRec will allow GRO to contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while you are overseas. With an official application through EduRec, you will also be able to request GRO for supporting letters for visa application and NS deferment (for NSmen).</p> <p>Please read the EduRec application guide before applying for the programme with NUS.</p>
8	Course Mapping	<p>Students interested in transferring units can start the course mapping process after applying and accepting the offer for the programme in EduRec. Course mapping request is subjected to approval from the Faculties. Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for course mapping.</p> <p>Please also note the following: Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme and up to a maximum of 5 units for each Winter Programme. Course mapping will be subject to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools.</p> <p>A total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition.</p>
