COVID-19 related updates:

Due to the fluid situation of the COVID-19 pandemic, there is still much uncertainty regarding international travel in the months ahead.

Students' ability to travel to Australia for summer 2022 will be determined by the host country's travel policies as well as the latest travel advice from Singapore authorities. In the event that Singapore authorities advise against non-essential travel to Australia for summer 2022, students will not be able to travel to Australia for their summer programmes.

To be eligible for physical (on-site) summer programmes, students will need to:

1. fully vaccinated
2. complete the compulsory Overseas Travel Preparedness (OTP) module on LumiNUS one month before the programme start date;
3. submit a copy of the completed Risk Acknowledgement and Consent Form on LumiNUS (folder within the OTP module);

Students who proceed with the physical (on-site) option acknowledge the risks associated. NUS will not be responsible for any lost deposits or expenses (including but not limited to programme/tuition fees, air tickets, housing deposits, meal plans and/or non-academic student fees) associated with travel disruptions.

You are advised NOT to make any financial commitments particularly those which are non-refundable until you are certain that travel is possible. You will be fully responsible for any travel expenses, quarantine accommodation costs, COVID-19 tests or other costs.

5	Eligibility Requirements	General NUS Requirements : <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Full-time NUS undergraduates 2. Students must complete the programme before their conferment date 3. Meet any additional requirements (e.g. CAP score etc.) imposed by the host university 4. Have a clean disciplinary record and be a strong ambassador for NUS and Singapore in order to be eligible for the programme University of Adelaide’s requirements: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Completed at least one year of study at your home university • Achieved a GPA of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale • Meet prerequisites for your selected courses
6	Accommodation	There are various temporary accommodation options for students attending the Winter School. Visit the University of Adelaide’s website for more information about accommodation.

7	Application Procedure	<p>Apply via myEduRec and with the host university concurrently. You must accept both the myEduRec offer as well as the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme.</p> <p>Students are advised to read the application guide before applying for the programme with NUS.</p> <p>Once you have accepted the offer on myEduRec and confirmed that you will be participating in the programme, you must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Complete the Overseas Travel Preparedness (OTP) module on LumiNUS at least 1 month before your programme start date 2. Upload the completed “Risk Acknowledgement and Consent Form” on LumiNUS at least 1 month before your programme start date
8	Module Mapping	<p>Students interested in obtaining credit can start the module mapping process after you apply in myEduRec and accept the offer for the programme. Module mapping request is subjected to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools. Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for module mapping.</p> <p>Students may map up to a maximum of 10 MCs for each Summer Programme. A total of 12 MCs from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional MCs mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees.</p>

9	Visa Application	<p>Students may enter Australia with a Visitor Visa. Please check the visitor visa type applicable for your nationality from this link https://www.border.gov.au/Trav/Visi/Visi. Singaporean should apply for the Electronic Travel Authority visa (subclass 601).</p> <p>It is student’s responsibility to ensure that they obtain a valid visa before making any travel arrangement for their summer programme. Obtaining a visa may be time consuming. Students are encouraged to prepare and apply for a visa as early as possible. The host university will send the documents required for your visa application to the address that you have indicated on your application for the summer programme after you have completed the payment for the programme. Kindly ensure that you have indicated your address correctly to avoid any delays.</p>

11	Student Insurance	<p>Insurance coverage for official NUS trips is provided for your participation in this programme.</p> <p>The host university may require you to submit a copy of your insurance</p>
