5	Eligibility Requirements	<p>General NUS Requirements:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Full-time NUS undergraduates 2. Students must complete the programme before their conferment date 3. Meet any additional requirements (e.g. CAP score etc.) imposed by the host university 4. Have a clean disciplinary record and be a strong ambassador for NUS and Singapore in order to be eligible for the programme
6	Accommodation	<p>Students have the option to stay at UQ St Lucia's on-campus accommodation which consists of 10 residential colleges or to explore off-campus options from UQ-approved accommodation providers.</p> <p>Visit UQ's website for more information about accommodation.</p>
7	Application Procedure	<p>Apply via myEduRec and with the host university concurrently. You must accept both the myEduRec offer as well as the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme.</p> <p>Students are advised to read the application guide before applying for the programme with NUS.</p>
8	Module Mapping	<p>Students interested in obtaining credit can start the module mapping process after you apply in myEduRec and accept the offer for the programme. Module mapping request is subjected to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools. Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for module mapping.</p>

		Students may map up to a maximum of 10 MCs for each Summer Programme. A total of 12 MCs from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional MCs mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees.

9	Visa Application	<p>Students may enter Australia with a Visitor Visa. Please check the visitor visa type applicable for your nationality from this link https://www.border.gov.au/Trav/Visi/Visi. Singaporean should apply for the Electronic Travel Authority visa (subclass 601).</p> <p>It is student's responsibility to ensure that they obtain a valid visa before making any travel arrangement for their summer programme. Obtaining a visa may be time consuming. Students are encouraged to prepare and apply for a visa as early as possible. The host university will send the documents required for your visa application to the address that you have indicated on your application for the summer programme after you have completed the payment for the programme. Kindly ensure that you have indicated your address correctly to avoid any delays.</p>
