4	Academic Content	<p>Units of study (Courses) are taught with the same academic rigour and study workload as a normal semester. Each unit is taught in an intensive format and worth 6 USYD credit points. Most of units have no pre-requisites. 6	Accommodation	<p>Students can apply for guaranteed accommodation at Scape and Queen Mary Building. Both buildings are situated 15 minutes' walk from campus and are on the doorstep of downtown Sydney. Each provider has their own social calendar, including activities such as a weekly sausage sizzle (BBQ) and pancake breakfast to promote a community atmosphere.</p> <p>Guaranteed accommodation options can only be booked via a special application form that is provided to students after an Unconditional Offer has been issued.</p> <p>Estimated cost: \$359 - \$489** per week (depending on room selection and availability)</p>

Students must apply concurrently with NUS and SJTU LEC at: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) NUS Education Records System (EduRec) – accept the offer to proceed with course mapping and financial aids application (if applicable). b) Contact sydneyabroad.specialprograms@sydney.edu.au for application details. 2. Accept both the EduRec offer and the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme.
8	Course Mapping	<p>Students interested in transferring units can start the course mapping process after applying and accepting the offer for the programme in EduRec. Course mapping request is subjected to approval from the Faculties. Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for course mapping.</p> <p>Please also note the following: Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme and up to a maximum of 5 units for each Winter Programme. Course mapping will be subject to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools.</p> <p>A total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional units mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees. For details, visit the Office of the University Registrar's website.</p>

9	Visa Application	Students may enter Australia with a Visitor Visa . Please check the visitor visa type applicable for your nationality. Singaporean students should apply for the Electronic Travel Authority visa (ETA, subclass 601).

		Students should obtain a valid visa before making any travel arrangement for their summer programme. It is recommended to prepare and submit the visa application as soon as the necessary documents from the host university are available.
