The number of credits varies between summer or winter schools. Recognition of credits in the home curriculum should be agreed upon with the home institution. It is the participant's responsibility to do so. In this regard, a course information sheet can be provided for each summer or winter school.</p>
5	Eligibility Requirements	<p>NUS' generic eligibility requirements apply, please see GRO website for details. Applications and selections are subject to review by the host university.</p> <p>Host university's entry requirements: Entry requirements for the summer and winter schools vary depending on the specific programme. Generally, these courses are tailored for (master) students, researchers, and professionals with a keen interest in the subject matter. It's essential to review the specific target group and prerequisites for each course before applying. Detailed information about entry requirements can be found on the individual course pages.</p>
6	Accommodation	<p>The University of Antwerp has four different campuses. The majority of summer or winter schools hosted by Antwerp Summer and Winter University take place at the Stadscampus of the University of Antwerp, situated close to the city centre. However, certain summer or winter schools are organised at campuses outside the city centre, such as Campus Drie Eiken, Campus Groenenborger, or Campus Middelheim. Prior to making a reservation, please verify at which campus your specific summer or winter school takes place and check the distances.</p> <p>UAntwerp provides all accepted students with a list of housing options, ranging from available student rooms over youth hostels to traditional hotels, in different price categories and at different locations. All participants are free to choose their</p>

		<p>preferred accommodation. In certain summer and winter schools, accommodation is included in the package.</p> <p>For more information, please refer to: https://www.uantwerpen.be/en/life-in-antwerp/housing/.</p> <p>Should university-arranged accommodation not be available, you will be responsible for securing your accommodation.</p>
7	Application Procedure	<p>Apply to NUS via EduRec and to UAntwerp via UAntwerp's website concurrently.</p> <p>You must accept both the EduRec offer and the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme.</p> <p>Only upon acceptance of the EduRec offer can you proceed with course mapping and application for financial aids.</p> <p>Applying on EduRec will allow GRO to contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while you are overseas. With an official application through EduRec, you will also be able to request GRO for supporting letters for visa application and NS deferment (for NSmen).</p> <p>Please read the EduRec application guide before applying for the programme with NUS.</p>
8	Course Mapping	<p>Students interested in transferring units can start the course mapping process after applying and accepting the offer for the programme in EduRec. Course mapping request is subjected to approval from the Faculties. Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for course mapping.</p> <p>Please also note the following: Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme and up to a maximum of 5 units for each Winter Programme. Course mapping will be subject to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools.</p> <p>A total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional units mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees. For details, visit the Office of the University Registrar's website.</p>
9	Transcript	<p>Please provide a valid, personal mailing address to the host university so that the host can send your transcript to you directly after the programme. If the host issues an electronic transcript, please provide your personal NUS email address to receive the transcript.</p> <p>Please do not request your transcript to be sent to NUS Global, and NUS Global is not responsible for missing transcripts.</p>

10	Visa Application	<p>Check the following website to find out if you need a Schengen visa for a stay of up to 90 days: https://dofi.ibz.be/en/themes/entry/border-control/visa/visa-type-c/list-third-countries-whose-nationals-are-exempted.</p> <p>If you have any other nationality, you have to apply for a visa type C/ Schengen visa at the Belgian embassy or consulate in your current country of residence before going to Belgium. Kindly note that if a visa application is required, UAntwerp recommends submitting your programme and visa applications by 12 March 2026, as visa processing may take up to three months.</p> <p>If you require GRO to issue a supporting letter for your visa application, NS deferment or OSP loan application, you may submit your request via this form after you have applied in EduRec and received confirmation of acceptance from the host university.</p>
11	Travel Advisories	<p>Visit the MFA website for travel advisories on various countries from the Singapore government.</p>
12	Student Insurance	<p>All participants will be insured for third party liability and accidents during summer school activities by UAntwerp. Additional insurances (e.g. health and travel), as well as travel costs are the participant's own responsibility.</p> <p>NUS Student Travel Insurance is provided for your participation in this programme. Please request a certificate of insurance from the insurer directly following the instructions detailed in: https://myportal.nus.edu.sg/studentportal/student-insurance/all/. (Log in using your NUSNET ID and password.)</p> <p>Students are responsible for ensuring that they have sufficient travel insurance coverage for the full duration of their trip (including travelling). Please review the insurance coverages to ensure that they meet your needs. Students may purchase additional health and/or travel insurance from their preferred agent.</p>
