4	Academic Content	Each student will take up <u>one</u> themed interdisciplinary course package. In this three-week academic intensive, students will complete 90 hours of course instruction and lab time and earn two UBC micro-credentials upon completion of the program. Each course package comprises of two related courses taught by world-class UBC instructors. (Please note: Students have to complete the course mapping process in NUS to seek approval for awarding of units. Refer to Item 8 for more details.) Areas of Studies Business, Communications, Engineering, Health, Psychology and Sociology.

8	Course Mapping	 You can start the course mapping process after you apply in EduRec and accept the offer for the programme. Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for course mapping. Also note the following: Maximum of 2 courses (up to 10 units) can be mapped per summer / research programme during Special Term (May – August). Maximum of 1 course (up to 5 units) can be mapped per winter / research programme during year-end vacation (December – January). Total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional units mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees.
