4	Academic Content	<p>Apacheta is a 4-week Spanish language and cultural immersion experience that integrates a Spanish Course with 10 seminars about doing business in Latin America and its cultural perspective.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Spanish Language Course A1 level - carries 10 UC Credits (equivalent to 6 ECTS credits) Doing Business in Latin America - consists of 5 seminars introducing business culture in Latin America and the Chilean Innovation Ecosystem Intercultural Mediation in Latin America - consists of 5 seminars introducing the basics of intercultural mediation in Latin America <p>(Please note: Students have to complete the course mapping process in NUS to seek approval for awarding of units. Refer to Item 8 for more details.)</p> <p>Refer to the programme website for more info.</p>
5	Eligibility Requirements	NUS' generic eligibility requirements apply, please see GRO website for details.
6	Accommodation	UC Chile does not have its own university residences but will recommend affordable and suitable accommodation for programme participants.
7	Application Procedure	<p>Apply via EduRec and the host university's website <u>concurrently</u>.</p> <p>You must accept both the EduRec offer as well as the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme.</p>
8	Module Mapping	<p>You can start the module mapping process after you apply in EduRec and accept the offer for the programme. Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for module mapping. Also note the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Maximum of 2 modules (up to 10 MCs) can be mapped per summer / research programme during Special Term (May – August). Maximum of 1 module (up to 5 MCs) can be mapped per winter / research programme during year-end vacation (December – January). Total of 12 MCs from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional MCs mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees.
