If a student has transferred 4 MCs from an electronic summer programme in 2020, only a maximum of 4 MCs can be transferred from an electronic summer programme in 2021.</p> <p>Module mapping* is subject to approval by the respective faculties; refer to this list of <a href="#">FAQs</a> for additional information.</p> <p>A total of 12 MCs from a maximum of 2 summer/winter and research programmes (inclusive of electronic/online programmes) can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional MCs mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees.
