Selected students will be informed on 22 April to submit application with UESTC by 30 April 2026 (DUT application deadline). 3. Once you have accepted the internal offer on EduRec, NUS Global will nominate you to DUT for fee-waiver. 4. Please follow the instructions from DUT to complete your application/registration processes. 5. Ensure that you receive the acceptance from DUT to confirm your participation in the programme.
