4	Academic Content	4 SJTU credits content courses in Economics, Business, Social Sciences, Humanities, Mathematics and Natural Sciences etc. Students are allowed to take 1 to 3 courses. Each course comprises 15 lectures in total delivered every week from Monday to Friday. Each lecture lasts 160 minutes with a short interval between topics. The total class time is 40 hours. In addition to class sessions, students are required to attend at least 2.5-hour discussion session every week, amounting to 10 hours in total. The total academic time for each course is 50 hours (3000 minutes), which amounts to 4 SJTU credits. Please visit https://summercourse.sce.sjtu.edu.cn/weben/classes_course.htm for course listing. Please also note the following: Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme and up to a maximum of 5 units for each Winter Programme. Course mapping will be subject to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools. A total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional units mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees.
