Once you have accepted the internal offer on EduRec, NUS Global will nominate you to UESTC for fee-waiver. 4. Please follow the instructions from UESTC to complete your application/registration processes. 5. Ensure that you receive the acceptance from UESTC to confirm your participation in the programme.
