7	Application Procedure at NUS	Apply via the <u>NUS Education Records System (EduRec - GE)</u> first if you want to do module mapping and apply for financial aid/loans. Applying through EduRec-GE will allow GRO to contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while you are overseas. With an official application through EduRec-GE, you are covered by the NUS Travel Blanket Insurance. Besides, GRO can also provide you with supporting letters for visa application. Read the step-by-step guide which we have prepared for you on <u>GRO's web.</u> You should also apply to the host university <b>concurrently</b> once you have submitted an application to NUS EduRec.
8	Application Procedure at host university	Refer to the host university website for the application procedures and list of supporting documents.
9	Course Mapping	<ul> <li>All course mapping requests are subjected to approval by the Faculties/Departments.</li> <li>If you are interested in obtaining credits for your course, you can start the course mapping process after you have accepted the offer for the programme via EduRec-GE.</li> <li>Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme. Over the course of study in NUS, students may map up to a total of 12 units for involvement in the summer programme. Beyond 12 units, NUS Special Term tuition fees will apply, in addition to Summer/Winter Programme fees paid to the host university. 10	Visa Application	Singapore passport holders do not need a visa to travel to Czechia (for visits less than 90 days). However, medical insurance is required for the duration of the stay. The travel medical insurance must conform to the following requirements (for	
		<ul> <li>visits up to 90 days):</li> <li>Coverage of cost incurred as a result of medical repatriation, emergency medical and hospital treatment or death;</li> <li>Coverage of up to the amount of at least 30,000 EUR (45,000 USD);</li> <li>Cover the entire period of your stay in the Schengen area; and</li> <li>Cover the entire territory of the Schengen area.</li> </ul> Students are advised to contact the Czech Embassy/Consulate in Singapore/Home	
		country if they have specific visa questions and are required to keep themselves updated for the latest immigration policies via the website of the Embassy/Consulate and from the host university.
