7	Application Procedure	<p>Apply via the host university's website. Your status when applying to the host university (University of Copenhagen) is "Non-EU/EEA without permanent Danish residence permit".</p> <p>Thereafter, inform Jasper Tang via email (grottd@nus.edu.sg) about the course(s) you applied for. You will then be provided instructions on applying via EduRec (a critical step for your module mapping and financial aid applications). You must accept both the EduRec offer as well as the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme.</p>
8	Module Mapping	<p>All mapping requests are subjected to approval by the Faculties/Departments.</p> <p>Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for module mapping. Students may contact the SEP administrators/coordinators at their respective home Faculty/School Dean's Office or the academic department for module mapping. NUS Business School will not consider a summer programme of fewer than 3 weeks duration to be credit-bearing.</p> <p>If you are interested in obtaining credits, you can start the module mapping process after you have accepted the offer for the programme via EduRec-GE.</p>

		Students may map up to a maximum of 10 MCs for each Summer Programme. Over the course of study in NUS, students may map up to a total of 12 MCs for involvement in summer programme. Beyond 12MCs, NUS Special Term tuition fees will apply, in addition to Summer/Winter Programme fees paid to the host university. For details, please read the information on Registrar’s Office website .
