7	Application Procedure	<p>Apply to NUS via EduRec and to AU via AU's website concurrently.</p> <p>When applying with AU, NUS students must apply as a "freemover" student, NOT an exchange student. The application guide can be found here.</p> <p>You must accept both the EduRec offer and the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme.</p> <p>Only upon acceptance of the EduRec offer can you proceed with course mapping and application for financial aids.</p> <p>Applying on EduRec will allow NUS Global to contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while you are overseas. With an official application through EduRec, you will also be able to request NUS Global for supporting letters for visa application and NS deferment (for NSmen).</p> <p>Please read the EduRec application guide before applying for the programme with NUS.</p>
8	Course Mapping	<p>Students interested in transferring units can start the course mapping process after applying and accepting the offer for the programme in EduRec. Course mapping request is subjected to approval from the Faculties. Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for course mapping.</p> <p>Please also note the following: Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme and up to a maximum of 5 units for each Winter Programme. Course mapping will be subject to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools.</p>

		A total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional units mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees. For details, visit the Office of the University Registrar's website .

If the host issues an electronic transcript, please provide your personal NUS email address to receive the transcript.</p> <p>Please do not request your transcript to be sent to NUS Global, and NUS Global is not responsible for missing transcripts.</p>

10	Visa Application	<p>Check the following website to find out if you need a visa: https://nyidanmark.dk/en-GB/You-want-to-apply/Short-stay-visa/Cultural-visa.</p> <p>If you need to apply for a short-term visa, AU will contact you directly, once you have accepted your seat / paid the course fee. AU will send you a visa invitation form (VU3), that you can use when you make the visa application at the relevant embassy / consulate.</p> <p>Please note that if you need a visa, your passport must be valid until at least three months after the expiry date of the visa.</p> <p>Please note that visa processing by the Danish Immigration Service can take up to 45 days. AU therefore recommends applying to AU Summer University in the first application round (by 18 March). This will allow sufficient time for AU to review your application, issue the visa invitation letter, and for the Danish Immigration Service to process your visa before your arrival in Denmark.</p> <p>In some countries, it can be very difficult to get a time for an appointment at the visa administration office, some offices have month-long waiting lists to get an appointment. So, it is a good idea to start the visa application process as early as possible.</p> <p>If you require NUS Global to issue a supporting letter for your visa application, NS deferment or OSP loan application, you may submit your request via this form after you have applied in EduRec and received confirmation of acceptance from the host university.</p>
11	Travel Advisories	Visit the MFA website for travel advisories on various countries from the Singapore government.
12	Student Insurance	NUS Student Travel Insurance is provided for your participation in this programme. Please request a certificate of insurance from the insurer directly following the instructions detailed in: https://myportal.nus.edu.sg/studentportal/student-insurance/all/ . (Log in using your NUSNET ID and password.)
