7	<b>Application Procedure</b>	<p>Apply to NUS via <a href="#">EduRec</a> and to UCPH concurrently.</p> <p>The specific application procedures to apply to UCPH and deadlines for each course can be found on the individual course webpages at <a href="https://www.ku.dk/education/international-summer-programme">https://www.ku.dk/education/international-summer-programme</a>.</p> <p>You <b>must</b> accept both the EduRec offer and the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme.</p> <p>Only upon acceptance of the EduRec offer can you proceed with course mapping and application for financial aids.</p>

		<p>Applying on EduRec will allow NUS Global to contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while you are overseas. With an official application through EduRec, you will also be able to request NUS Global for supporting letters for visa application and NS deferment (for NSmen).</p> <p>Please read the <a href="#">EduRec application guide</a> before applying for the programme with NUS.</p>
8	<b>Course Mapping</b>	<p>Students interested in transferring units can start the course mapping process after applying and accepting the offer for the programme in EduRec. Course mapping request is subjected to approval from the Faculties. Click <a href="#">here</a> for a step-by-step guide on applying for course mapping.</p> <p>Please also note the following: Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme and up to a maximum of 5 units for each Winter Programme. Course mapping will be subject to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools.</p> <p>A total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. 9	<b>Transcript</b>	<p>Please provide a valid, <b>personal</b> mailing address to the host university so that the host can send your transcript to you directly after the programme. If the host issues an electronic transcript, please provide your <b>personal NUS email address</b> to receive the transcript.</p> <p>Please do not request your transcript to be sent to NUS Global, and NUS Global is not responsible for missing transcripts.</p>
<b>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION</b>		
10	<b>Visa Application</b>	<p>Singaporeans can visit Denmark for up to 90 days within 180 days from the date of initial entry within the Schengen region without a visa, provided no employment is pursued.</p> <p>Denmark is part of the Schengen area. Entry into any of the 26 European countries in the Schengen area for short-term tourism, a business trip, or in transit to a non-Schengen destination, requires a minimum three months' passport validity beyond the intended date of departure. Singaporeans should have their passports with them when crossing borders, even within the Schengen area.</p> <p>As immigration requirements can change at short notice, travelers are advised to contact their travel agent or the <a href="#">Embassy of Denmark in Singapore</a> for the latest information.</p> <p>If you are of other nationalities, please check the following website to find out if you need a visa: <a href="https://nyidanmark.dk/en-GB/You-want-to-apply/Short-stay-visa/Cultural-visa">https://nyidanmark.dk/en-GB/You-want-to-apply/Short-stay-visa/Cultural-visa</a>.</p>

		<p>Please note that the process can be time consuming, UCPH recommends applying for a visa as soon as your enrolment has been confirmed and you have paid the tuition fee.</p> <p>In some countries, it can be very difficult to get a time for an appointment at the visa administration office, some offices have month-long waiting lists to get an appointment. So, it is a good idea to start the visa application process as early as possible.</p> <p>If you require NUS Global to issue a supporting letter for your visa application, NS deferment or OSP loan application, you may submit your request via this <a href="#">form</a> after you have applied in EduRec and received confirmation of acceptance from the host university.</p>
11	<b>Travel Advisories</b>	Visit the <a href="#">MFA website</a> for travel advisories on various countries from the Singapore government.
12	<b>Student Insurance</b>	<p><a href="#">NUS Student Travel Insurance</a> is provided for your participation in this programme. (Log in using your NUSNET ID and password.)</p> <p><b>Students are responsible for ensuring that they have sufficient travel insurance coverage for the full duration of their trip (including travelling).
