4	Academic Content	<p>Courses within classic business disciplines are offered, such as Accounting, Communication, Economics, Finance, Management, Marketing, Organisation, Strategy and Statistic. Interdisciplinary courses such as, CSR and sustainability, Entrepreneurship, Globalisation, Information Technology, Innovation, Psychology, Supply Chain Management and Logistics are also offered.</p> <p>For further details, you may refer to the course website.</p>
5	Eligibility Requirements	<p>NUS' generic eligibility requirements apply, please see GRO website for details. Applications and selections are subject to review by the host university.</p> <p>CBS strongly recommend that you make sure you fulfil the prerequisites for the courses you want to apply for. Refer to the Course preparation page for more information.</p>
6	Accommodation	<p>There are limited number of dormitory rooms, thus accommodation is not guaranteed. Students who apply for 6-week courses will have priority.</p> <p>For CBS Summer University, rooms can be leased for either four or six weeks. This means that if you are enrolled in a two- or three-week course, you may stay in a student residence, but you will be required to pay for a minimum four-week rental period.</p> <p>For more information, please refer to: https://www.cbs.dk/en/study-programmes/summer-university/international-summer-university-students.</p> <p>Should university-arranged accommodation not be available, you will be responsible for securing your accommodation.</p>
7	Application Procedure	<p>Apply to NUS via EduRec and to CBS via CBS' website concurrently. When applying to CBS, you should apply as a non-European student/Freemover.</p> <p>You must accept both the EduRec offer and the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme.</p> <p>Only upon acceptance of the EduRec offer can you proceed with course mapping and application for financial aids.</p> <p>Applying on EduRec will allow NUS Global to contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while you are overseas. With an official application through EduRec, you will also be able to request NUS Global for supporting letters for visa application and NS deferment (for NSmen).</p>

8	Course Mapping	<p>Students interested in transferring units can start the course mapping process after applying and accepting the offer for the programme in EduRec. Course mapping request is subjected to approval from the Faculties. Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for course mapping.</p> <p>Please also note the following: Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme and up to a maximum of 5 units for each Winter Programme. Course mapping will be subject to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools.</p> <p>A total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional units mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees. For details, visit the Office of the University Registrar's website.</p>
9	Transcript	<p>Please provide a valid, personal mailing address to the host university so that the host can send your transcript to you directly after the programme. If the host issues an electronic transcript, please provide your personal NUS email address to receive the transcript.</p> <p>Please do not request your transcript to be sent to NUS Global, and NUS Global is not responsible for missing transcripts.</p>
