5	<b>Application Procedure</b>	You are <b>REQUIRED TO</b> apply via NUS' <a href="#">EduRec-GE</a> <b>AND</b> the host university's website <u>concurrently</u> . Please note that you must accept <u>both</u> NUS EduRec offer as well as the host university offer in order to confirm your participation in this programme.
6	<b>Module Mapping</b>	Students interested in obtaining credit can start the module mapping process after you apply in EduRec and accept the offer for the programme. Module mapping request is subject to approval from the Faculties. <a href="#">Click here</a> for a step-by-step guide on applying for module mapping.  Students may map up to a maximum of 10 MCs for each <b>on-site</b> Summer Programme and up to a maximum of 5 MCs for each Winter Programme. Module

7	<b>Visa Application</b>	<p>Students from countries on <a href="#">section 1 of the list</a> need to apply for a visa for a stay in Spain of over three months to get their visas on time they should make their applications two months before the course starts, by writing to the appropriate <a href="#">Spain consular office</a>, depending on where they live.</p> <p>Students are reminded to check the Spain Consular Office in Singapore/home country for updates of the latest immigration policies via the website of the Embassy/Consulate and the information from the host university.</p>
8	<b>Travel Advisories</b>	Visit the <a href="#">MFA website</a> for travel advisories on various countries from the Singapore government.
9	<b>Student Insurance</b>	<p>NUS students are covered under the NUS Students Travel Insurance scheme for official NUS trips. Please refer to <a href="https://myportal.nus.edu.sg/studentportal/student-insurance/all/">https://myportal.nus.edu.sg/studentportal/student-insurance/all/</a> for details.</p> <p>However, students are advised to read through and understand its policy (coverage) and to review whether the terms and conditions as well as the duration of coverage are sufficient to suit their needs and to cover their entire journey abroad.
