PROGRAMME DETAILS		
4	<b>Academic Content</b>	<p>The UAB Barcelona Summer School offers a range of undergraduate courses in various fields. Most courses are taught in English, enabling students to earn either 6 ECTS credits over a 3-week period or 12 ECTS credits by completing two 3-week periods. Courses offered are in the following areas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Arts and Humanities</li> <li>• Biosciences</li> <li>• Sciences</li> <li>• Engineering</li> <li>• Health Sciences</li> <li>• Social Sciences</li> </ul> <p>In order to avoid any overlaps in the schedules, you can only enrol in one course per period. In total, you can enrol in up to 2 courses, one during the first period and another one during the second period. 5	<b>Eligibility Requirements</b>	<p>NUS' generic eligibility requirements apply, please see <a href="#">GRO website</a> for details. Applications and selections are subject to review by the host university.</p> <p>Host university requires you to be a current NUS student, having completed at least half of your first-year study.</p>
6	<b>Accommodation</b>	<p>You may choose to stay on UAB Campus or in Barcelona City.</p> <p>For more information, please refer to: <a href="https://www.uab.cat/web/accommodation-1345844077540.html">https://www.uab.cat/web/accommodation-1345844077540.html</a>.</p> <p>Should university-arranged accommodation not be available, you will be responsible for securing your accommodation.</p>
7	<b>Application Procedure</b>	<p>Apply to NUS via <a href="#">EduRec</a> and to UAB concurrently. The application guide to UAB's application portal can be found at: <a href="https://www.uab.cat/web/uab-barcelona-summer-school-1345844075637.html">https://www.uab.cat/web/uab-barcelona-summer-school-1345844075637.html</a>.</p> <p>You <b>must</b> accept both the EduRec offer and the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme.</p> <p>Only upon acceptance of the EduRec offer can you proceed with course mapping and application for financial aids.</p> <p>Applying on EduRec will allow NUS Global to contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while you are overseas. With an official application through</p>

		<p>EduRec, you will also be able to request NUS Global for supporting letters for visa application and NS deferment (for NSmen).</p> <p>Please read the <a href="#">EduRec application guide</a> before applying for the programme with NUS.</p>
8	<b>Course Mapping</b>	<p>Students interested in transferring units can start the course mapping process after applying and accepting the offer for the programme in EduRec. Course mapping request is subjected to approval from the Faculties. Click <a href="#">here</a> for a step-by-step guide on applying for course mapping.</p> <p>Please also note the following: Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme and up to a maximum of 5 units for each Winter Programme. Course mapping will be subject to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools.</p> <p>A total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional units mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees. For details, visit the <a href="#">Office of the University Registrar's website</a>.</p>
9	<b>Transcript</b>	<p>Please provide a valid, <b>personal</b> mailing address to the host university so that the host can send your transcript to you directly after the programme. If the host issues an electronic transcript, please provide your <b>personal NUS email address</b> to receive the transcript.</p> <p>Please do not request your transcript to be sent to NUS Global, and NUS Global is not responsible for missing transcripts.</p> <p>Students enrolled in the UAB Barcelona Summer School will get their academic record to the email address provided between 10 and 30 September. The issue of further copies will be subject to the payment of the corresponding fee.</p>

10	<b>Visa Application</b>	<p>Check the following website to find out if you need a Schengen visa for a stay of up to 90 days: <a href="https://schengenvisainfo.com/who-needs/">https://schengenvisainfo.com/who-needs/</a>.</p> <p>Should you require a Schengen visa, a visa application must be submitted within 180 days before the date of your trip (and no later than 15 days before the date of your trip). You should verify the website or bulletin board of the consulate that pertains to you.</p> <p>If you require NUS Global to issue a supporting letter for your visa application, NS deferment or OSP loan application, you may submit your request via this <a href="#">form</a> after you have applied in EduRec and received confirmation of acceptance from the host university.</p>
