Applications and selections are subject to review by the host university.</p> <p>Host university requires you to be at least 18 years old. Pre-requisites may apply for certain courses.</p>  |
| 6                 | <b>Accommodation</b>            | <p>Two types of accommodation are offered to participants: shared double rooms and single rooms.</p> <p>The cost of accommodation is included in the programme fee.</p> <p>Should university-arranged accommodation not be available, you will be responsible for securing your accommodation.</p>  |
| 7                 | <b>Application Procedure</b>    | <p>Apply to NUS via <a href="#">EduRec</a> and to UAL via the <a href="#">sign-up form</a> concurrently.</p> <p>You <b>must</b> accept both the EduRec offer and the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme.</p> <p>Only upon acceptance of the EduRec offer can you proceed with course mapping and application for financial aids.</p> <p>Applying on EduRec will allow NUS Global to contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while you are overseas. You should verify the website or bulletin board of the consulate that pertains to you.</p> <p>If you require NUS Global to issue a supporting letter for your visa application, NS deferment or OSP loan application, you may submit your request via this <a href="#">form</a> after you have applied in EduRec and received confirmation of acceptance from the host university.</p>   |
