7	Application Procedure	<p>Apply to NUS via EduRec and to IE University via https://my.ie.edu/en/applysum/?agreement=001549 concurrently. When applying to IE University, you have to apply via the highlighted weblink in order to enjoy NUS discount, if any.</p> <p>You must accept both the EduRec offer and the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme.</p> <p>Only upon acceptance of the EduRec offer can you proceed with course mapping and</p>

		<p>application for financial aids.</p> <p>Applying on EduRec will allow NUS Global to contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while you are overseas. With an official application through EduRec, you will also be able to request NUS Global for supporting letters for visa application and NS deferment (for NSmen).</p> <p>Please read the EduRec application guide before applying for the programme with NUS.</p>
8	Course Mapping	<p>Students interested in transferring units can start the course mapping process after applying and accepting the offer for the programme in EduRec. Course mapping request is subjected to approval from the Faculties. Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for course mapping.</p> <p>Please also note the following:</p> <p>Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme and up to a maximum of 5 units for each Winter Programme. Course mapping will be subject to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools.</p> <p>A total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional units mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees. For details, visit the Office of the University Registrar's website.</p>
9	Transcript	<p>Please provide a valid, personal mailing address to the host university so that the host can send your transcript to you directly after the programme. If the host issues an electronic transcript, please provide your personal NUS email address to receive the transcript.</p> <p>Please do not request your transcript to be sent to NUS Global, and NUS Global is not responsible for missing transcripts.</p>

10	Visa Application	<p>Check the following website to find out if you need a Schengen visa for a stay of up to 90 days: https://schengenvisainfo.com/who-needs/.</p> <p>Should you require a Schengen visa, a visa application must be submitted within 180 days before the date of your trip (and no later than 15 days before the date of your trip). You should verify the website or bulletin board of the consulate that pertains to you. Once you finish your enrolment process, the Student Services department at IE University will send you your academic visa supporting documents.</p> <p>If you require NUS Global to issue a supporting letter for your visa application, NS deferment or OSP loan application, you may submit your request via this form after you have applied in EduRec and received confirmation of acceptance from the host university.</p>

12	Student Insurance	<p>NUS Student Travel Insurance is provided for your participation in this programme.
