7	Application Procedure	 Please write to NUS GRO, Ms Wei Lin weilin@nus.edu.sg providing the programme name and programme duration for programme set-up in EduRec. Apply concurrently in NUS Education Records System (EduRec) and to HKU Summer Institute programme directly. Students are required to accept offer in NUS Education Records System (EduRec) in order to proceed with module mapping and submission of financial aid application. Final acceptance to the summer programme is decided by HKU Summer Institute. 	
8	Module Mapping	For credit-bearing programme, students interested in obtaining credit can start the module mapping process after applying and accepting the offer for the programme in EduRec. Module mapping request is subjected to approval from the Faculties. Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for module mapping. Also note the following: Students may map up to a maximum of 10 MCs for each Summer Programme and up to a maximum of 5 MCs for each Winter Programme. Module mapping will be subject to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools. A total of 12 MCs from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional MCs mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees.
