4	Academic Content	<p>PolyU offers a diversified range of subjects from three thematic learning tracks for students' selection:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chinese Language, Culture and Society • Design, Innovation and Technology • Business, Entrepreneurship and Global Leadership <p>Students are expected to take one subject, but students may take two subjects when places are available. 5	Eligibility Requirements	NUS' generic eligibility requirements apply, please see GRO website for details.
6	Accommodation	All non-local fee-paying students must stay at the student hostel. Rooms are on twin-sharing basis and roommate is assigned on a random basis.
7	Application Procedure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Apply via NUS Education Records System (EduRec) and the CUHK website <u>concurrently</u>; • Apply as 'Non-local Fee-paying' students for the programme; • Final acceptance to the summer programme is decided by the host university. • Applicants must accept both the EduRec offer as well as the PolyU offer to confirm participation in this programme.
8	Module Mapping	<p>Students interested in obtaining credit can start the module mapping process after applying and accepting the offer for the programme in EduRec. Module mapping request is subjected to approval from the Faculties. Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for module mapping. Also note the following:</p> <p>Students may map up to a maximum of 10 MCs for each Summer Programme and up to a maximum of 5 MCs for each Winter Programme. Module mapping will be subject to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools.</p> <p>A total of 12 MCs from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional MCs mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees. For details, visit the Registrar's Office website.</p>
