Leadership Academy for Responsible Global Citizenship: One World, Our World

“Leadership Academy for Responsible Global Citizenship” (LARGC), organised by Service-Learning and Leadership Office, is a pioneering international education and exchange programme on the themes of global leadership and responsible citizenship development. LARGC aims to educate students on issues of civic responsibility and leadership through PolyU’s well-structured Service-Learning programmes in a cross-cultural and boundary-crossing setting.

Participating students will join one of two PolyU’s service-learning subjects: “Community engagement through expressive textile arts and fashion” and “Technology Beyond Borders: Service Learning across Cultural, Ethnic and Community Lines”. They will learn about the challenges faced by their target community in Hong Kong, and acquire knowledge and skills to serve them through an innovative service project. Through this service, students will learn to develop empathy and a sense of social responsibility. Students will actualize the project to create real impact. Supplementing the service project will be talks from world-renowned experts, open dialogues, interactive hands-on workshops and local field visits, on the theme of social diversity and inclusion.

The Service-Learning subjects

From PolyU’s renowned Institute of Textile and Clothing, students will learn about fashion design and expressivity, and the skills, innovation, and hands-on techniques in creating wearable textile art. Armed with this knowledge, they will co-design a garment together with youth with disabilities and their families, in the process empowering them to regain positive well-being and express feelings through their unleashed talents.
- **Technology Beyond Borders: Service Learning across Cultural, Ethnic and Community Lines**
From PolyU’s Department of Computing, students in this subject will acquire and master the skills and techniques necessary to design and implement an interactive technology product using Augmented Reality (AR). This product will be designed for severely mentally and physically handicapped children, to assist with their daily needs, or to serve as entertainment and training for them.
