		and up to a maximum of 5 units for each Winter Programme. Course mapping will be subject to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools.

9	Visa Application	If you do not have the right of abode in Hong Kong, regardless of the length of study, you are required by law to obtain a Student Visa issued by the Hong Kong Immigration Department (ImmD). You must submit the visa application online as soon as you receive a Notice of Admission from HKUSI . The visa application process takes approximately 10 to 12 weeks .
