5	Eligibility Requirements	<p>To apply for Pécs Summer School 2026, you will need the following documents for a valid application:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be a registered NUS student 2. Be at least 18 years old, 3. Submit the following documents during your application: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Proof of sufficient English for subject courses - at least intermediate language level (i.e. TOEFL, IELTS, TOEIC, CEP, Cambridge certificate, mother tongue, etc.). b. Proof of German language proficiency (for German language courses) Please refer to the Common European Language Framework of Reference for Languages. c. Individuals whose educational background and experience qualify them for the courses they wish to take, and who have submitted their statement of purpose (letter of motivation). <p>In addition to that, NUS' generic eligibility requirements apply, please see the GRO website for details.</p>
6	Accommodation	<p>The dormitory is located in the city centre and you will be placed in two-bedded rooms. There are two rooms per housing unit equipped with private bathroom and kitchen. Address: Pécs, Breuer Marcell sétány 2, 7622</p>
7	Application Procedure at NUS	<p>Please apply through the NUS Education Records System - Global Education (EduRec-GE) first if you want to do course mapping and apply for financial aid/loans. Applying through EduRec-GE will allow GRO to contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while overseas.</p> <p>With an official application through EduRec-GE, you are covered by the NUS Travel Blanket Insurance. Besides, GRO can also provide you with supporting letters for visa application. Read the step-by-step guide we prepared for you on GRO's website.</p> <p>You should also concurrently apply to the host university once you have applied to NUS Edu-Rec.</p>
8	Application Procedure at Host University	<p>To apply for this programme, you need to submit an online application via the programme page ('How to Apply'):</p> <p>https://summerschool.ptt.hu/programs</p>

9	Confirmation of participation	To confirm your participation in this Programme, you must accept both the EduRec offer and the host university's offer to confirm your participation in this programme.
10	Course Mapping	<p>All course mapping requests are subject to approval by the faculties/departments.</p> <p>If you are interested in obtaining credits for your course, you can start the course mapping process via EduRec-GE after you have accepted the programme offer.</p> <p>Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme. Over the course of study in NUS, students may map up to a total of 12 units for involvement in the summer programme. Beyond 12 units, NUS Special Term tuition fees will apply, in addition to Summer/Winter Programme fees paid to the host university. Please read the information on the Office of the University Registrar's website for details.</p>
11	Transcript	<p>Please provide a valid, personal mailing address in the online registration portal so the host can send your transcript to you after the summer programme.</p> <p>Please do not request that your transcript be mailed to the NUS Global Relations Office (GRO). GRO is not responsible for missing transcripts.</p>

12	Visa Application	Holders of a Singapore passport do not require a visa for visits to Hungary lasting up to 90 days. For other nationalities, please enquire with the Embassy of Hungary in Singapore for visa requirements.
