Students can take one course for the 2 weeks programme and two courses for the 3 weeks programme. Courses offer include Computer Science, Economics, Engineering, Law, Humanities, Political Science and

5	Eligibility Requirements	<p>General NUS Requirements:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Full-time NUS undergraduates 2. Students must complete the programme before their conferment date 3. Meet any additional requirements (e.g. CAP score etc.) imposed by the host university 4. Have a clean disciplinary record and be a strong ambassador for NUS and Singapore in order to be eligible for the programme
6	Accommodation	<p>The host university will provide you with more details regarding accommodation arrangement. Should university-arranged accommodation is not available, you will be responsible for securing your own accommodation.</p>
7	Application Procedure	<p>Apply via myEduRec and with the host university concurrently. You must accept both the myEduRec offer as well as the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme.</p> <p>Students are advised to read the application guide before applying for the programme with NUS.</p>
8	Module Mapping	<p>This is a non-credit bearing programme.</p>

9	Visa Application	<p>Singaporean and some nationals may enter Indonesia without visa or eligible to apply for visa on arrival for a certain period of time. Please check your visa requirement from this link http://www.imigrasi.go.id/index.php/en/.</p> <p>It is student's responsibility to ensure that they obtain a valid visa before making any travel arrangement for their summer programme. Obtaining a visa may be time consuming. Students are encouraged to prepare and apply for a visa as early as possible. The host university will send the documents required for your visa application to the address that you have indicated on your application for the summer programme after you have completed the payment for the programme. Kindly ensure that you have indicated your address correctly to avoid any delays.</p>
