Moreover, immerse yourself in a different culture, and discover something new about yourself through multidisciplinary studies. An exclusive 9 (nine) days study program (2 ECTS credits) will offer a high-quality, and multidisciplinary course taught in English by professors and lecturers of many disciplines (Conservation and Climate Change, Art, Earth Sciences, Agriculture, Marine Science and Biology, Resource Sciences, Humanities, Anthropology, and Sociology) and by top practitioners from the scientist and companies around the world. The destinations are Unpad Campus Jatinangor, Cisolok Geyser, Ciletuh Palabuhanratu UNESCO Global Geopark, Bandung City, and Tangkubanparahu Stratovolcano.
