2	<b>Financial Aid Available Through NUS GRO</b>	<p>Financial Aid options will not be available for programmes/classes that are conducted fully online. If programmes are hybrid, only on-site participation would qualify a student for financial aid. If a physical/on-site programme switches to fully online before the commencement of the programme, NUS reserves the right to adjust or retract the financial aid package.</p> <p><b>However, eligible students will receive the NUS India Experience Award (IEA) which can be applied through EduRec.</b> This will serve to provide financial support for students participating in India-related online programmes. PROGRAMME DETAILS		
3	<b>Academic Content</b>	Ashoka University offers an intensive online six-week study programme held during the summer. A range of four-credit courses is offered across the liberal arts and science disciplines. Some of the courses include Indian Civilizations; Creative Writing; Philosophy of Love; Introduction to Comparative Politics; Media, Culture, and Society; Mind and Behaviour. Moreover, NUS students will have the opportunity to interact virtually with both international and local (Indian) students, as well as participate in cultural immersion activities arranged by the host university. Some online social and cultural activities that NUS students can look forward to include virtual tours of cultural sites of India, speaker series, social mixers, book clubs, coursework related small group hangouts, reading groups, weekend activities, and more.
4	<b>Eligibility Requirements</b>	<p>NUS' generic eligibility requirements apply, please see <a href="#">GRO website</a> for details.</p> <p>Host university requires undergraduate students to be currently enrolled full-time in any foreign educational institution.</p>

5	<b>Application Procedure</b>	<p>1. 6	<b>Module Mapping</b>	<p>If you are interested in obtaining credit, you can start the module mapping process after you apply in EduRec and accept the offer for the programme. <a href="#">Click here</a> for a step-by-step guide on applying for module mapping.</p> <p>NUS has made special arrangements for students who wish to map modules from electronic / online summer programmes in 2021 (May to August 2021 / Special Term Parts 1 &amp; 2). A maximum of 8 MCs can be transferred from electronic summer programmes during a student's course of study at NUS, and will count towards the Special Term tuition fee waiver of 12 MCs. Beyond 12MCs, NUS Special Term tuition fees will apply, in addition to Summer/Winter Programme fees paid to the host university. Some Faculties/Schools (including School of Computing) will not approve module mapping for online courses. Please check with your home faculty's Dean's Office to determine if module mapping can be approved for online courses before applying to the partner university.
