PROGRAMME DETAILS		
4	Academic Content	<p>The International Summer School, New Delhi is an intensive, six-week academic program that brings together students from across the world. The 2020 session comprises of a 4-week academic session and an optional 2-week service learning experience. Distinguished academics from institutions such as the Jawaharlal Nehru University, Jamia Millia Islamia, Delhi University, Ashoka University, Shiv Nadar University, OP Jindal Global University among others from India as well as overseas will be delivering lessons on the following themes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Politics, Governance and International Relations - Growth, Development & Sustainability - Gender, Culture & Society - Technology, Innovation & the Future of Work <p>The optional Service Learning allows students to engage with India through a series of workshops, excursions and a volunteer experience to build on the knowledge gained from the academic sessions.</p>
5	Eligibility Requirements	<p>NUS' generic eligibility requirements apply, please see GRO website for details.</p> <p>The ISS requires students to be currently enrolled full-time in any higher education institution. The programme is open to both undergraduates and postgraduates. However, the GRO IEA is only applicable to NUS undergraduate students.</p>
6	Accommodation	<p>During the four-week Academic Session, students will be staying at Hotel Samrat, and during the optional, two-week Service Learning experience, students will be staying in guest houses. For more details, refer to the host programme website.</p>
7	Application Procedure	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. You must apply concurrently via <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • EduRec and • host programme online application website (for Stage 2 of the application process, NUS students are exempted from submitting the Letter of Recommendation) 2. You must accept both the <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • EduRec offer and • host programme offer in order to confirm your participation in this programme <p>Students are advised to read the application guide before applying for the programme with NUS.</p>

8	Module Mapping	<p>If you are interested in obtaining credit, you can start the module mapping process after you apply in EduRec and accept the offer for the programme. Note that all mapping requests are subjected to approval by the Faculties. Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for module mapping.</p> <p>Students may map up to a maximum of 10 MCs for each Summer Programme. Over the course of study in NUS, students may map up to a total of 12 MCs for summer programmes. Beyond 12MCs, NUS Special Term tuition fees will apply, in addition to Summer/Winter Programme fees paid to the host university. For details, visit the Registrar’s Office website.</p>

9	Visa Application	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> For non-Indian nationals, student visa is required. For details, visit the website of the High Commission of India in Singapore. Visa applicants, including Singapore Citizens and PR, need to apply at the official Indian visa website. The ISS will ensure the provision of relevant documents that may help in the visa application process. <p>Note: It is student’s responsibility to ensure that they obtain a valid visa before making any travel arrangements for their summer programme. Students are encouraged to prepare and apply for visa as early as possible as obtaining a visa can be time consuming.</p>
10	Travel Advisories	<p>Visit the MFA website for travel advisories on various countries from the Singapore government.</p>
11	Student Insurance	<p>Insurance coverage for official NUS trips is provided for your participation in this programme, which must be shared with the ISS in order to complete the admission process. Students are responsible for ensuring that they have sufficient travel insurance coverage.</p>
