5	Eligibility Requirements	<p>NUS' generic eligibility requirements apply, please see GRO website for details.</p> <p>Ashoka University's requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be enrolled as a full-time student at NUS • Must have completed a minimum of 1 year of university level study by the time you start at Ashoka • A cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale (That's about 3.75/5.0 in NUS' context)
6	Accommodation	<p>Refer to the host university's website for the accommodation arrangements.</p> <p>Below is an excerpt from the host university's website: All international visiting students are guaranteed campus accommodation in fully-furnished residence halls with laundry service. Rooms are on double-occupancy basis. Single room accommodation is not available. Visiting international students are housed with Ashoka students to encourage intercultural exchange. Students receive a meal plan (buffet and combo meals) at the dining facilities of Ashoka.</p> <p>A full residential campus with fully air-conditioned rooms, common student lounges, state of the art classrooms and sprawling lawns, the Ashoka University campus is designed for a vibrant student life.</p>
7	Application Procedure	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. You must apply concurrently via <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NUS Education Records System (EduRec) and • Host university's application portal 2. You must accept both the internal offer in EduRec and the host university's offer to confirm your participation in this programme <p>✓ Only upon acceptance of the EduRec offer can you proceed with course mapping and application for financial aids.</p> <p>✓ Applying on EduRec will allow GRO to contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while you are overseas. With an official application through EduRec, you will also be able to request GRO for supporting letters for visa application and NS deferment (for NSmen).</p> <p>Please read the EduRec application guide before applying for the programme with NUS.</p>
8	Course Mapping	<p>Students interested in transferring units can start the course mapping process after applying and accepting the offer for the programme in EduRec. Course mapping request is subjected to approval from the Faculties. Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for course mapping. Also note the following:</p>

		<p>Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme and up to a maximum of 5 units for each Winter Programme. Course mapping will be subject to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools.</p> <p>A total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional units mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees. For details, visit the Office of the University Registrar's website.</p>

9	Visa Application	<p>Singapore Passport holders will need to apply for an e-Visa for entry to India. More information can be found here. For other nationalities, please check with the India Embassy or the relevant authorities from your home country.</p> <p>As visa requirements often change at short notice, we advise you to contact the High Commission of India in Singapore for up-to-date information.</p>

11	Student Insurance	<p>NUS Student Travel Insurance is provided for your participation in this programme.
