6	Application Procedure	You are REQUIRED TO apply via <u>EduRec</u> . NUS Global will forward the applications received via EduRec to AUR directly and they will contact you with the relevant course registration and pre-departure information. You are NOT REQUIRED to submit an application via AUR website.

		Please note that you must accept <u>both</u> the EduRec offer as well as the host university offer in order to confirm your participation in this programme.
7	Course Mapping	If you are interested in obtaining credit, you can start the course mapping process after you apply in EduRec and accept the offer for the programme.
		Note that all mapping requests are subjected to approval by the Faculties.
		Please also note the following:
		 Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each summer programme and up to a maximum of 5 units for each winter programme. Course mapping will be subject to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools.
		 Of the units approved for mapping, a total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional units mapped will be subjected to NUS Special Term fees. For details, visit the <u>NUS Office of the</u> <u>University Registrar's website</u>.

8	Visa Application	Holders of a Singapore passport do not require a visa for visits to Italy lasting up to 90 days. However, it is a requirement for entry to Italy that your passport is valid for at least three months after the intended date of departure from the Schengen Area.
