Your home faculty at NUS will determine the conversion of UNICATT credits to NUS credits.</p>
5	Eligibility Requirements	<p>Entry requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Grade Point Average of a minimum of 2.75, or equivalent in the applicant’s university grading system - Completion of a minimum of 2 semesters at the undergraduate level (students in their second semester of study may apply) - Good level of English. Non-native English speakers must give evidence of their language proficiency of a minimum B2 level or equivalent (ex: TOEFL iBT 79, IELTS 6, First Certificate of English, Cambridge ESOL or other certification). <p>NUS’ generic eligibility requirements apply. Please refer to the GRO website for details.</p>
6	Accommodation	<p>Information on accommodation can be found here.</p> <p>If university-arranged accommodation is unavailable, you will be responsible for securing your own.</p>
7	Application Procedure at NUS	<p>Please apply through the NUS Education Records System - Global Education (EduRec-GE) first if you want to do module mapping and apply for financial aid/loans. Applying through EduRec-GE will allow GRO to contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while overseas.</p> <p>With an official application through EduRec-GE, you are covered by the NUS Travel Blanket Insurance. Besides, GRO can also provide you with supporting letters for visa application. Read the step-by-step guide we prepared for you on GRO’s web.</p> <p>You should also apply to the host university concurrently once you have applied to NUS Edu-Rec.</p>
8	Application Procedure at Host University	<p>To apply for this programme, you need to submit an online application via the Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore’s website.</p>

		<p>Students who wish to save on the application fee (75 €) must agree to provide the following information to UNICATT and complete their EduRec-GE application by Thursday, 27 March 2025, 5 pm:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Name (including middle name, as indicated in your passport) - Surname (including all given surnames as indicated on your passport) - Date of birth - Place of birth, birth continent and birth territory - Personal email - Phone number (including the country code) <p>The questions mentioned above can be found in the EduRec-GE application. Students who provide the above information must submit their application using the ‘Partner University Application’.</p> <p>GRO will submit your nomination to UNICATT on <u>1 April 2025</u>. Applications received <u>after</u> 27 March 2025 will not be eligible for the discount on the application fee.</p> <p>Students uncomfortable providing the abovementioned application will be required to submit their application under ‘Free mover/Direct Application’. They will not enjoy the discount on the application fee (75 €)</p> <p>Students interested in the winter school must complete their applications by <u>15 April 2025</u>.</p>
9	Confirmation of participation	<p>The host will inform you via email of your acceptance or rejection. Please request a confirmation letter from UNICATT for your Italian visa application (if needed).</p> <p>To confirm your participation in this programme, you must accept the EduRec-GE offer and the host university offer.</p> <p>Please read the cancellation policy of this programme before accepting and paying for the programme.</p>
10	Course Mapping	<p>All course mapping requests are subject to approval by the faculties/departments.</p> <p>If you are interested in obtaining credits for your course, you can start the course mapping process via EduRec-GE after you have accepted the programme offer.</p> <p>Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme. Over the course of study in NUS, students may map up to a total of 12 units for involvement in the summer programme. Beyond 12 units, NUS Special Term tuition fees will apply, in addition to Summer/Winter Programme fees paid to the host university. Please read the information on the Office of the University Registrar’s website for details.</p>

12	Visa Application	<p>A Singapore passport holder does not require a visa for visits to Italy lasting up to 90 days. Please contact the Embassy of Italy in Singapore regarding the visa requirements for other nationalities.</p> <p>If you need a visa to enter Italy, please start early, as your application may take up to two months.</p>
13	Travel Advisories	<p>Visit the MFA website for travel advisories from the Singapore government in various countries.</p>
