1	Programme Fee

The program fee varies from € 1,550 (one course) € 2,900 (two courses\*) and € 4,250 (three courses\*), excluding the 75 € application fee.

The fees include the following:

- Enrollment fee (80 €)
- 44 contact hours
- Academic site visits
- Study material
- Transcript of records
- Access to campus facilities (students' restaurant, libraries, health centre, etc)
- Students' service team support
- Orientation
- Welcome activities and welcome lunch

The fees do not include:

- Travel expenses, accommodation, local transportation, and meals.

7	Application Procedure at NUS	Please apply through the NUS Education Records System - Global Education (EduRec-GE) first if you want to do module mapping and apply for financial aid/loans. Applying through EduRec-GE will allow GRO to contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while overseas.  With an official application through EduRec-GE, you are covered by the NUS Travel Blanket Insurance. Besides, GRO can also provide you with supporting letters for visa application. Read the step-by-step guide we prepared for you on GRO's web.  You should also apply to the host university concurrently once you have applied to NUS Edu-Rec.
8	Application Procedure at Host University	To apply for this programme, you need to submit an online application via the Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore's website.



		Students who wish to save on the application fee (75 €) must agree to provide the following information to UNICATT and complete their EduRec-GE application by <a href="https://doi.org/10.108/j.com/">Thursday, 27 March 2025, 5 pm</a> :

		The questions mentioned above can be found in the EduRec-GE application. Students who provide the above information must submit their application using the 'Partner University Application'.
		GRO will submit your nomination to UNICATT on <u>1 April 2025</u> . Applications received <u>after</u> 27 March 2025 will not be eligible for the discount on the application fee.
		Students uncomfortable providing the abovementioned application will be required to submit their application under 'Free mover/Direct Application.' They will not enjoy the discount on the application fee (75 €)
		Students interested in the winter school must complete their applications by $\underline{15}$ April 2025.
9	Confirmation of participation	The host will inform you via email of your acceptance or rejection. Please request a confirmation letter from UNICATT for your Italian visa application (if needed).
		To confirm your participation in this programme, you must accept the EduRec-GE offer and the host university offer.
		Please read the cancellation policy of this programme before accepting and paying for the programme.
10	Course Mapping	All course mapping requests are subject to approval by the faculties/departments.
		If you are interested in obtaining credits for your course, you can start the course mapping process via EduRec-GE after you have accepted the programme offer.
		Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme. Over the course of study in NUS, students may map up to a total of 12 units for involvement in the summer programme. Beyond 12 units, NUS Special Term tuition fees will apply, in addition to Summer/Winter Programme fees paid to the host university. Please read the information on the Office of the University Registrar's website for details.

12	Visa Application	A Singapore passport holder does not require a visa for visits to Italy lasting up to 90 days. Please contact the Embassy of Italy in Singapore regarding the visa requirements for other nationalities.  If you need a visa to enter Italy, please start early, as your application may take
		up to two months.
13	Travel Advisories	Visit the MFA website for travel advisories from the Singapore government in various countries.
14	Student Insurance	NUS will continue to offer NUS Travel Insurance for approved study abroad programmes, including summer/winter programs (SWP).
