7	Application Procedure	<p>For students who apply by 25 Mar 2026:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Apply in EduRec by 25 Mar 2026, providing ALL information requested below: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Your full name (as per your passport) b. Your surname c. Your date of birth (in DD/MM/YYYY format) d. Your place of birth, birth continent and birth territory (e.g. Singapore, Asia, Singapore) e. Your mobile number (please include country code if it's not a Singapore number) f. Desired Cattolica campus (Milan or Rome) 2. Apply at UNICATT's portal by 15 Apr 2026 <p>NUS will nominate students on a rolling basis before 1 Apr 2026 so that students can enjoy the €75 application fee waiver. You will receive instructions from UNICATT on how to complete your application at their portal once nomination by NUS is received. Kindly note that NUS will NOT nominate you if you fail to provide the relevant information as stipulated above by 25 Mar 2026.</p> <p>For students who apply after 25 Mar 2026 and students who do not wish to submit their personal details to NUS Global:</p> <p>Apply concurrently via EduRec and UNICATT as a Free-mover applicant by 15 Apr 2026.</p> <p>For all the note:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You must accept both the EduRec offer and the host university offer to confirm your participation in this programme. • Only upon acceptance of the EduRec offer can you proceed with course mapping and application for financial aids. • Applying on EduRec will allow GRO to contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while you are overseas. With an official application through EduRec, you will also be able to request GRO for supporting letters for visa application and NS deferment (for NSmen). <p>Please read the EduRec application guide before applying for the programme with NUS.</p>
8	Course Mapping	<p>Students interested in transferring units can start the course mapping process after applying and accepting the offer for the programme in EduRec.
