8	Course Mapping	<p>Students interested in obtaining credit can start the course mapping process after you apply in EduRec and accept the offer for the programme. NUS Business School will not consider summer programme of less than 3 weeks duration to be credit bearing.</p> <p>Students may map up to a maximum of 10 Units for each Summer Programme. Over the course of study in NUS, students may map up to a total of 12 Units for involvement in summer programme. Beyond 12 Units, NUS Special Term tuition fees will apply, in addition to Summer/Winter Programme fees paid to the host university. 10	Visa	<p>Students from countries or regions where Korea has signed a Visa waiver agreement may enter Korea without a visa for the summer programme.</p> <p>Singaporeans are not required to obtain a visa.</p> <p>Please visit the K-ETA website and check if your country is listed in the drop-down list. If you are unable to locate your country in the drop-down list, please apply for an appropriate visa.</p> <p>If you are able to locate your country in the drop-down list, please apply for K-ETA online if your purpose of entry is tourism, business, short-term study or family visit. However, if your purpose of visit is not covered by K-ETA or if your K-ETA application has been denied, please apply for an appropriate visa.</p> <p>It is student's responsibility to ensure that they obtain a valid visa before making any travel arrangement for their summer programme. Obtaining a visa may be time consuming. Students are encouraged to prepare and apply for a</p>

		<p>visa as early as possible. The host university will send the documents required for your visa application to the address that you have indicated on your application for the summer programme after you have completed the payment for the programme. Kindly ensure that you have indicated your address correctly to avoid any delays.</p> <p>If you require GRO to issue a supporting letter for your visa application, you may submit your request via this form after you have applied in EduRec and received confirmation of acceptance from the host university.</p>

12	Student Travel Insurance	<p>All international students and non-SKKU students are required to be properly insured. If a student chooses SKKU Group Insurance the insurance fee will be automatically purchased when students pay for the tuition.</p> <p>SKKU Group Insurance Insurance fees are included in the tuition.
