ESTIMATED COST OF PARTICIPATION

1 Programme Fee

In the 2023 Winter Abroad at Yonsei, Yonsei University offers a 3-week winter program at their Sinchon campus for international students who would like to enjoy the winter in Seoul.

Winter Abroad at Yonsei is originally composed of two separate sessions: Session 1 is a 3-week program focusing on academic achievement with various courses and Session 2 is a 2-week program with an intensive Korean language course along with distinguished cultural and historical lectures related to Korean society. Unfortunately, the Session 2 program has since been canceled after COVID-19.

Registration Fee: KRW100,000

Tuition: KRW1,650,000 for 1 course / KRW2,850,000 for 2 courses / KRW3,650,000 for 3 courses

Early Bird Promotion:

- KRW250,000 for 1 course
- KRW430,000 for 2 courses
- KRW550,000 for 3 courses

*Early Bird Promotion is given to those who 1) complete online application and application fee payment by 12 Oct 2023 and 2) receive acceptance letter and make full tuition fee payment by 26 Oct 2023.

*Students that are part of the Early Bird Promotion will also be given early bird

^{*}The programme period overlaps slightly with NUS Semester 2, please check with your home faculty whether you are required to apply for a short-term LOA. Otherwise, please keep your lecturers informed that you will be missing some classes in week 1.

3 Financial Aid Available Through NUS GRO

Financial Aid options will not be available for programmes/classes that are conducted fully online. If programmes are hybrid, only on-site participation would qualify a student for financial aid. If a physical/on-site programme switches to fully online before the commencement of the programme, NUS reserves the right to adjust or retract the financial aid package.

You should have enough monetary funds to last you throughout the whole i-SP. Your decision to go on i-SP should not be dependent upon the confirmation of a scholarship or bursary award. You can consider the following financial aid options to fund your i-SP:

For Singaporeans only:

- NUS Awards for Study Abroad (NASA) Enhancement Bursary
- Overseas Student Programme (OSP) Loan
- Post-Secondary Education Account (PSEA) Funds

Please note that if you are successful for any financial aid, the funds will only be disbursed to you after completion of the programme.

6	Accommodation	On-campus accommodation (check-in 26 Dec 2023, check-out 18 Jan 2024) is available on a first-come-first-served basis; applications open from 2 – 8 Nov 2023. 7	Application Procedure	Electronic winter programmes taken while physically in Singapore, whilst credit-bearing by the partner universities, are offered to NUS students for enrichment only. Module mapping and financial assistance are not applicable to any electronic winter programmes taken while physically in Singapore. For online courses (no travel to Korea), please apply directly to the host university – EduRec application is NOT required.
		 For on-site programmes (travelling to Korea): Apply concurrently on NUS Education Records System (EduRec) Yonsei WAY online application Please note that an official transcript will be required for application. An electronic copy of official transcript will also be acceptable.
		Both the EduRec offer as well as the host university offer must be accepted to confirm participation in this programme.
		Only upon acceptance of the EduRec offer can you proceed with module mapping and apply for financial aid.
		Applying on EduRec will allow GRO to contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while you are overseas. With an official application



		 through EduRec, you will also be able to request GRO for supporting letters for visa application and NS deferment (for NSmen). Please read the <u>application guide</u> before applying for the programme with NUS.
8	Course Mapping	If you are interested in obtaining credit, you can start the course mapping process after you apply in EduRec and accept the offer for the programme. Note that all mapping requests are subjected to approval by the Faculties. Click here for a step-by-step guide on applying for course mapping.
		For clarification, students may contact the SEP administrators/coordinators at their respective home Faculty/School Dean's Office or the academic department.
		Course mapping request is subjected to approval from the Faculties.

9	Visa Application	Students from countries or regions where Korea has signed a Visa waiver agreement may enter Korea without a visa for the winter programme. Singaporeans are not required to obtain a visa. Students from other countries not listed in the visa exemption list must apply for a short-term study visa (D-2-8) on their own. The list of countries with visa exemption is available at the Korean Embassy website. It is student's responsibility to ensure that they obtain a valid visa before making any travel arrangement for their winter programme. Obtaining a visa may be time consuming. Students are encouraged to prepare and apply for a visa as early as possible. The host university will send the documents required for your visa application to the address that you have indicated on your application for the summer programme after you have completed the payment for the programme. Kindly ensure that you have indicated your address correctly to
