		A total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional units mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees. For details, visit the Office of the University Registrar's website.

		For students of other nationalities, please visit the <u>K-ETA website</u> and check if your country is listed in the drop-down list. If you are unable to
		locate your country in the drop-down list, please apply for an appropriate visa.
		If you are able to locate your country in the drop-down list, please apply for K-ETA online if your purpose of entry is tourism, business, short-term study or family visit. However, if your purpose of visit is not covered by K-ETA or if your K-ETA application has been denied, please apply for an <u>appropriate visa</u> .
		It is the student's responsibility to ensure that they obtain a valid visa before making any travel arrangement for their summer programme. Obtaining a visa may be time consuming. Students are encouraged to prepare and apply for a
		visa as early as possible. The host university will send the documents required for your visa application <u>upon request</u> .
