7	<b>Application Procedure</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. You <b>must</b> apply concurrently via <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">EduRec</a> (in order to be able to proceed with course mapping and submission of financial aids application) and</li> <li>• host university's <a href="#">application portal</a></li> </ul> </li> <li>2. You <b>must</b> accept both the <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• EduRec offer and</li> <li>• host university offer in order to confirm your participation in this programme.</li> </ul> </li> </ol> <p>✓ Only upon acceptance of the EduRec offer can you proceed with course mapping and apply for financial aid.</p> <p>✓ Applying on EduRec will allow NUS Global to contact and assist you in times of crisis/emergency while you are overseas. With an official application through EduRec, you will also be able to request for supporting letters for visa application and NS deferment (for NSmen).</p> <p>✓ Please read the <a href="#">application guide</a> before applying for the programme with NUS.</p>

8	<b>Course Mapping</b>	<p>Students interested in transferring units can start the course mapping process after applying and accepting the offer for the programme in EduRec. Course mapping request is subjected to approval from the Faculties. Click <a href="#">here</a> for a step-by-step guide on applying for course mapping.</p> <p>Please also note the following: Students may map up to a maximum of 10 units for each Summer Programme and up to a maximum of 5 units for each Winter Programme. Course mapping will be subject to approval from the respective Faculties/Schools.</p> <p>A total of 12 units from a maximum of 2 overseas summer/winter and research programmes can be mapped without having to pay NUS tuition. Additional units mapped will be subjected to Special Term fees. For details, visit the <a href="#">Office of the University Registrar's website</a>.</p>
9	<b>Transcript</b>	<p>Please provide a valid, <b>personal</b> mailing address to the host university so that the host can send your transcript to you directly after the summer programme. If the host issues an electronic transcript, please provide your <b>personal NUS email address</b> to receive the transcript.</p> <p>Please do not request your transcript to be sent to NUS Global Relations Office (GRO). GRO is not responsible for missing transcripts.</p>

10	<b>Visa</b>	<p>Students from countries or regions where Korea has signed a Visa waiver agreement may enter Korea without a visa for the summer programme.</p> <p>Singaporeans are not required to apply for a visa or K-ETA. Exemption of K-ETA application for Singaporeans is until 31 December 2025. (Source: <a href="#">here</a>)</p> <p>For students of other nationalities, please visit the <a href="#">K-ETA website</a> and check if your country is listed in the drop-down list. If you are <b>unable</b> to locate your country in the drop-down list, please apply for an <a href="#">appropriate visa</a>.</p> <p>If you are <b>able</b> to locate your country in the drop-down list, please apply for K-ETA online if your purpose of entry is tourism, business, short-term study or family visit. However, if your purpose of visit is not covered by K-ETA or if your K-ETA application has been denied, please apply for an <a href="#">appropriate visa</a>.</p> <p>It is the student's responsibility to ensure that they obtain a valid visa before making any travel arrangement for their summer programme. Obtaining a visa may be time consuming. Students are encouraged to prepare and apply for a visa as early as possible.
